MEMBER SPOTLIGHT: MARY ELLEN JOYCE (AND WOODS COLLEGE)

The BC Club of Cape Cod scribe is immodestly featuring herself in this month's "spotlight." The purpose is to highlight degree/non-degree programs offered at **BC's Woods College of Advancing Studies**. I inadvertently learned of them while visiting the BC website searching for information to include in Club newsletters.

Woods is the fourth oldest school of the university. Founded in 1929 as a junior college it offered a pathway to a degree for adult learners. In 1935 it merged with BC's Extension School becoming the Boston College Intown Center (later the Evening College) headquartered at 126 Newbury Street in Boston. Moving to the Heights in the 1950s, it was renamed in 2002 in honor of Fr. James A. Woods, S.J. who served as Dean for 44 years.

In addition to several graduate degree programs, Woods offers certificates in Corporate Communications, Cybersecurity Risk Management and Strategy, Data Analytics, Leadership, Project Management, and National Security and Global Affairs.
